2	Ergonomic design, rugged and sturdy pipette. Suitable for multi-user environment.		
3	Air displacement type, single channel variable volume pipettes.		
4	fully autoclavable pipette upto +121 deg. Cel. For 20 min.		
5	Should be equipped with Hyper Blower System, longer second - push stroke, improves dispensing efficiency-for smaller dispensing volume pipette models.		
6	It should have easy digital volume setting.		
7	The pipette should be fully UV resistant		
8	It should have easy maintenance and can be easily calibrated within the laboratory		
9	The pipette should come with one-touch locking mechanism making it easy to lock the sample volume		
10	It should have PTFE seal / O-ring which ensures better air tightness and better chemical resistance		
11	The pipette should have ceramic plungers for models larger than 200 µl

13	The pipette must be supplied with a tube opener (both for snap-cap & screw cap), which can be attached to the pipette, so as to operate the tubes along-with pipetting

22	Manufacturer/bidder should clearly indicate typical life span / Life expectancy of the quoted equipment.		
23	Mention typical site requirements for the installation.		
24	Mention the time required to install the system.		
25	Bidders should clearly mention about compliance of the warranty and AMC/free service terms in the technical bid. Bids not fully complying to the warranty and AMC/free service terms are liable to be rejected.		
26	Item/Equipment quoted should not be a second hand/refurbished/on verge of obsolescence/outdated model. Similarly, after award of contract, the item supplied should be a newly manufactured item and not the old item already manufactured and stocked for more than 3 month.		

27	After opening of the Technical bid (Part-1), Physical demonstration of the quoted model may have to be shown / arranged by the bidder, if requested by the Institute. Physical demonstration may be shown at one of the end user's site/Principle company's application lab/manufacturing site located in Mumbai/Navi Mumbai/Thane cities. If there are no installations of the quoted model in Mumbai/Navi Mumbai/Thane cities, then the quoted model may have to be brought in at ACTREC for demo purpose within 15 days from the date of request. Physical Demonstration may be requested to confirm the availability of any or all technical features as mentioned/stated in the technical bid. Physical Demonstration will also be a part of technical evaluation process. If the bidder does not comply, such bids are liable to be disqualified. (Demonstration of quoted model is to be shown and not the demonstration of similar models with different technical specifications and features)		
28	Past experience of the bidders in terms of quality of supplied equipments, after sales service and application support will be taken into consideration while technical evaluation.. Bidders who has unsatisfactory past experience in last 2-3 years, in terms of quality of supplied equipments, after sales service and application support, bids of such bidders may liable to be rejected.		
29	Complete and detailed information should be provided in respect to each point specified in the specifications. <u>Technical bids that are incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.</u> Provide relevant supportive information, publications, catalogue, etc. Bidders providing misleading or wrong information are liable to be rejected. All technical claims should be printed in the technical brochure of the equipment.		
30	If any contradictory statements /figures/information is observed in the compliance chart and in the technical bid, then the technical information mentioned in the product literature/brochure will be considered true and further evaluation will be done based on the information given in the product literature/brochure. Regarding the warranty and free AMC terms, information quoted in the technical bid will only be taken as valid terms.		
31	Compliance column may be filled with relevant data, figures, range etc. as applicable. Do not just mention "YES / NO / Complied ".		
32	Provide list of current installations( in the last 2-3 years) of the quoted model in India. Contact details of the end users should be provided. Provide name of the end user, email ID, tel. no. etc.
