## **SCOPE OF WORK: -**

- 1. The scope of work to be visit at site and designs the civil structural as per the site condition, Contractor must approve design from Engineer In-charges before start of work.
- 2. Scope of work includes Supply of material as per the site requirement, fabrication by welding, bolting & riveting as per approved design. Finishing & painting with a primary coat of approved steel primer should be done.
- 3. All material including consumables and non-consumables are in scope of Contractor.
- 4. Carrying out the job with specified material as mentioned in BOQ.
- 5. Demolishing and reconstructing and plastering of the damaged wall, also apinting as per mentioned in BOQ and directed by EIC
- 6. Raising the height of gate level from ground on new level as instructed by EIC
