 - Details of Microscopic Findings along with immunophenotype
 - Other findings
 - Cytogenetics and Molecular Studies, if done
 - Proposed Diagnosis
- Participants may submit more than one case; however, a separate PowerPoint presentation must be prepared and submitted for each case.

All submitted cases will be reviewed and screened by an expert committee. Participants whose cases are selected for presentation will be notified accordingly.
